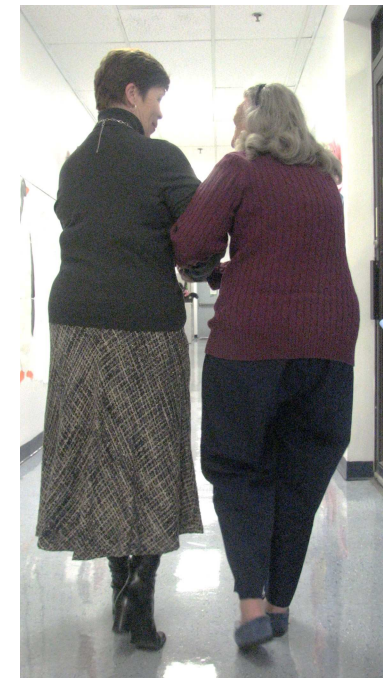

The growing incidence of Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia in the population means an increased need for highly trained caregivers at all levels of care.

The purpose of the Dementia Care Professionals of America (DCPA) Community Training program is to encourage increased knowledge and care skills for professional caregivers and further raise the bar on care for individuals with dementia. Successfully taking the training and exam and becoming an AFA Qualified Dementia Care Provider (QDCP) indicates an individual has reached a standard of excellence in dementia care.

The training, led by select staff of Day Haven Adult Day Services who are approved Community DCPA Trainers, incorporates video, live presentation, role playing and group discussions and will include the following topics:

- A basic understanding of dementia
- Management of activities of daily living
- Management of behavioral problems
- Principles of basic care

Upon completion of the training and after receiving a passing grade on the qualification exam, attendees will qualify as an AFA Dementia Care Provider and will receive free membership in DCPA, a membership certificate, an enameled membership pin, educational newsletters, professional discounts, and access to training Webinars.
